Fort Carson Gate access

A gate access list has been provided to both Gate 1 and Gate 5.

I suggest that you arrive early on June 28, 2023 to attain a pass at the gate to avoid any disruptions in getting to the course on time.

Visitors can apply online for a pass from their computer or mobile device at <https://visit.gvt.us>. Visitors will receive a background check, and after entering their information, including a driver's license or passport number, they will be notified if their pass is approved or denied. If approved, they can proceed to a kiosk at Visitor Control Center 1 for issuance of their pass.

If denied, please go to the Visitor Control Center front desk for assistance.

A sponsor is not required when applying for a pass online, but do require a valid purpose for visiting Fort Carson. This includes recreation and GOLF!

The VCC is located at Gate 1: Nelson Boulevard east of Colorado Highway 115, open 24/7

Local Rules/ Policies

1. All USGA Rules Apply
2. 150 yards from rock on right side of fairway (free drop)
3. 100 yards from rock on left side of fairway (free drop)
4. Free drop from maintenance area.
5. All water hazards are lateral and marked with red lines or stakes.
6. For pace of play all deadline areas will be played as lateral hazard. So if you are in this area you can choose to pick up your ball and 2 club lengths out from hazard no closer to hole and take a 1 stroke penalty.
7. All food and beverages must be purchased from Mulligan's Grill in the clubhouse.
8. All players must have their own clubs.
9. Proper golf attire must be worn. (Collard shirt, shorts or pants **NO jeans** women may wear skirts)
10. 90 degree rule in affect. Please keep carts on paths on par threes. Please keep carts out of native areas.
11. Please use caution when lightning is observed.
12. Course passed at 4 hours, 30 minutes
13. Please respect retreat at 5:00 PM
14. On holes 11 and 16 there is a drop zone.
15. Males will play from the white tees on all holes except 1,9,11 and 17 where they will play from the gold tees. Women/ Super Seniors will play from green tees.
16. Restrooms are located near holes 2,3,5,6,8 and 9 for the front nine. The Clubhouse is following hole 9 and 18 where there are restrooms for use. There are also restrooms between hole 14 and 15 on the back nine.
